Following the brutal terror attacks of October 7th, Hamas has continued to bombard Israelis with rockets, with Hezbollah and Iran also joining in on the deadly attacks. Aside from aerial attacks, Israel has seen a dramatic increase in terror attacks, including stabbings, shootings, and vehicular assaults.

In the immediate aftermath of the October 7th attacks, Magen David Adom activated all 1,550 of its existing ambulances, as well as its medicycles, helicopters, blood mobiles and all other vehicles.

Since then, Magen David Adom EMTs and paramedics have been treating the wounded, often while under rocket attack and gunfire themselves. As always, the men and women of MDA are risking their lives to save the lives of others.

How Magen David Adom is helping:

MDA is operating 24 hours a day, responding to all reported incidents and emergency calls across the entire country. Since October 7th, MDA has been on its highest alert level. EMTs and paramedics are treating the injured on the scene,

providing lifesaving treatment often in the midst of constant rocket attacks and gunfire. They are also transporting patients to hospitals via ambulances and helicopter to receive further treatment when necessary.

MDA's blood services division is supplying 100% of the blood needed by the IDF and is distributing blood units to all of Israel's hospitals, where injured civilians are being treated. In addition to using blood already in the blood bank, MDA is operating multiple blood drives across the country to ensure

they have the consistent supply they will undoubtedly continue to require. Thousands of Israelis have donated blood and hundreds are waiting in line – sometimes for hours – in order to donate.

Help is desperately needed at the moment to replenish supplies for EMTs and paramedics and for MDA's blood services division.

MDA's State-of-the-Art Blood Center: A New Era in Blood Donation and Safety

Magen David Adom's State-of-the-Art Blood Center: A New Era in Blood Donation and Safety

Magen David Adom (MDA), Israel's leading emergency medical service organization, has recently inaugurated a ground-breaking blood center that sets a new standard in blood donation and transfusion services. This cuttingedge facility integrates the latest advancements in medical technology, significantly enhancing the safety and efficiency of blood collection and processing.

Following October 7th, before it was slated to open, the brand new blood bank opened earlier

than expected, speeding up the timeline after understanding the magnitude of the attack.

"It became very clear we needed to move with the war plans because this was exactly the moment, the event it was built for," said Dr. Eilat Shinar, director of the national blood services division of Magen David Adom — Israel's medical emergency, disaster, ambulance and blood service.

This state-of-the-art center, the world's first underground antimissile blood facility, is designed to withstand earthquakes and natural disasters, ensuring the continuity of blood supply to the IDF and all Israeli's even in the most challenging conditions.



Ground-breaking Contributions and Services

MDA plays a critical role in supplying blood to hospitals and the Israel Defense Forces (IDF), responding to both civilian and military emergencies. As part of its collaboration with the IDF, MDA's Blood Services Division has introduced a vital program that provides whole blood units to combat soldiers on the frontlines, reducing battlefield fatal-

ities by 50%. Israel is among three countries globally using whole blood in this manner and is the only nation to deploy it directly on the battlefield.

Magen David Adom's new blood center not only increases the efficiency and safety of blood services but also underscores the organization's unwavering commitment to excellence and innovation in healthcare.

Menachem's Story:

On the evening before October 7th, Menachem began his shift as a paramedic at Tzohar station. At 6:30am on October 7th, MDA Israel Paramedic Menachem Blumenthal heard the rocket barrage that began targeting the Western Negev communities. The first call came in at 6:40am about someone with critical injuries, followed by information that Hamas terrorists had infiltrated Kibbutzim in the surrounding the Gaza envelop in Israel. Menachem understood that this would hinder

the evacuations of the wounded to hospitals as the terrorists were on the roads all around them. With a wounded person, Menachem decided that since they could not make it to the hospital, the community synagogue was close by so they drove the ambulance to the synagogue, quickly converting it into a field hospital, ready to take on additional casualties.

Understanding the magnitude, Menachem reached out to residents in the area who had medical training to come to the synagogue turned field hospital and bring any medical equipment they had, including the moshav's stretchers. He also contacted the MDA dispatch center asking that all ambulances be directed to the synagogue. Over the next many hours, Menachem and his team were taking in casualty after casualty, coordinating with the MDA dispatch center to bring in a

helicopter and the IDF to rescue victims. Menachem and his team treated and saved many people on October 7th, risking their lives while under constant threats and attacks from terrorists.

Oshrit's Story:


Oshrit, a 22 year old woman from Netivot, is an MDA paramedic in Ashdod. On October 7th, she immediately headed out to treat casualties at the Shuva Junction where MDA had already set up a field hospital. Over the next many hours, Oshrit put her life on the line with terrorists in the area in order to save the lives of many people. One man was seriously injured and grabbed her hand and asked her to say the "Shema Israel" prayer with him, knowing he would not make it.

During the morning, Oshrit's best friend Amit Man 22 years old, also a paramedic for MDA, was at Kibbutz



Beeri when the attacks began. Amit was offered the opportunity to leave and take cover and refused. Instead she chose to go to the clinic in the Kibbutz knowing that they were infiltrated by terrorists and understanding that the community would need her. Oshrit and Amit kept in touch throughout the morning until Oshrit stopped receiving communications. Amit was killed by terrorists wearing her medical gloves, her last moments putting others before herself. Oshrit now dedicates her heroic work with Magen David Adom to Amit.

Oshrit and Menachem are two exemplary Magen David Adom paramedics who embody selflessness and dedication, risking their own lives daily to save others. Their unwavering commitment, even in the face of a terrorist infiltration on October 7th, truly represents the essence of Magen David Adom—an organization founded on the principle of prioritizing the safety and well-being of Israel and its citizens. This extraordinary work is made possible through the generosity of our donors, whose support ensures that paramedics like Oshrit and Menachem have the essential equipment and training needed to perform their life-saving duties. Annual Charity Golf Tournament



A CMDA trophy was handed to Bobby Libin who is a great CMDA supporter.

The Katz family donated a Medical Scooter and were honoured on the stage for Benny Katz 95th birthday.

It was a great honor to have Rebecca Schulz, Minister of Environment and Protected Areas of Alberta, as our main speaker.

The Vital Role of Fundraising for Magen David Adom: A Personal Perspective

In a world often overshadowed by conflict and adver-

sity, organizations like Magen David Adom (MDA) serve as a beacon of hope and compassion. Dr. Dave Verkh,

a physician and healthcare executive, has witnessed this first-hand. As a member of the MDA Board of Directors and Chair of the Medical Committee, he cannot overstate the importance of raising funds for this noble cause. Alongside Sharon Fraiman, Director of the Western Region & Major Gifts for MDA, Dr. Verkh is committed to sharing their mission and the profound impact their collective efforts can have on humanity.

In the summer of 2014, during Operation Protective Edge, Dr. Verkh served as a senior medic with Magen David Adom. Those days were a true test of spirit and strength, as his team treated over 500 patients, each burdened by trauma that words could not fully capture. The emotional scars left

by these events were profound and lasting.

"One night, under a sky torn by conflict, our team received a call about a site hit by a Qassam rocket," recalls Dr. Verkh. "As we raced there, the thunder of our pounding hearts drowned out the blare of the sirens. We arrived to chaos, pain, and fear, yet amidst that turmoil, an unspoken bond of humanity emerged. We worked tirelessly, moving from one wounded soul to another, guided by training but driven by a deeper calling of compassion."

Touching lives

These experiences were not just about treating physical injuries; they were about touching lives and being there for people in their darkest hours. Healing extends beyond conventional medicine. It's about nurturing hope and building a community that stands together in both tranquility and tumult.

The recent crisis in Israel, marked by the harrowing news of Israeli hostages and the loss of thousands on October 7th, brings MDA's mission into sharp focus. These events are not distant; they

resonate deeply with many, including those in Canada. Each story of loss and bravery reflects a global family's shared humanity and collective strength.

"In this difficult time for Jewish people around the world, when antisemitism is at an all-time high, it is crucial that we stand together," says Dr. Verkh. "People are getting hurt. People are dying. It's even more crucial to take a stance—a stance against antisemitism, against hate, for unity, and for peace."

Beacon of hope

The challenges Magen David Adom faces today are overwhelming—shortages of medical supplies, ambulances under siege, and medical personnel working in perilous conditions. Yet, every action, no matter how small, can be a beacon of hope in these dark times. Contributions can provide life-saving medical supplies, protection for ambulances, and a symbol of solidarity with those risking their lives daily.

"Your donations are not just contributions; they are statements that, across oceans, our hearts, hopes, and support are with them," Dr. Verkh emphasizes.
"Each statistic represents a life — a person with dreams, a family, a story. I have looked into the eyes of these individuals, held their hands, heard their whispers of pain and their sighs of relief.
These are not just patients; they embody the resilience and strength of our people."

As the community reflects on the human stories behind the crisis, the call to action becomes clear. Standing together in moments of peace is important, but standing together in times of turmoil is crucial. The spirit of unity and support must be kept alive for ourselves, those who have fallen, and future generations.

Dr. Verkh's heartfelt message underscores the vital role of fundraising for Magen David Adom. Alongside Sharon Fraiman, he invites the community to join in this mission. Together, through empathy, action, and compassion, we can make a significant difference and bring light into the darkest of times.
